Charlotte developer plans buildings in Concord

Beacon Partners of Charlotte has bought land in The International Business Park at Concord and plans to construct speculative buildings on the site.

Beacon purchased 11 acres in the park, which is in northeast Charlotte, off of Interstate 85.

"The International Business Park's close proximity to Concord Regional Airport, Lowe's Motor Speedway and the N.C. Research Campus makes it the best location for a speculative building program in Cabarrus County," says Jon Morris, Beacon industrial partner.

The land is next to the International Corporate Center, which contains the **Connexions** call center.

The **Nolim Group SA Inc.**, based in Boca Raton, Fla, owns the park.
